FA CLASSIC MATCHES - 1991 FA CUP FINAL: NOTTINGHAM FOREST v TOTTENHAM

Tuesday 7th February at 10:00pm

As the 4th round of the FA Cup comes to a close this week, ESPN Classic relives some moments from the world's oldest knockout football competition, headlined by the 1991 FA Cup Final. Tottenham Hotspur won the competition after coming from 1-0 behind against Nottingham Forest to triumph 2-1 and take the trophy. It gave Spurs their eighth victory in nine FA Cup Finals and their first since their wins in 1981 and 1982.

BEST EVER RUGBY MATCHES: WALES V ENGLAND 1999

To mark the first week of the RBS Six Nations Championship, ESPN Classic has scheduled one of the all-time great rugby games between Wales and England. The game was played at Wembley, in England, but was considered a home game for Wales as their stadium was being rebuilt. The Welsh fans turned out in full force, as did the English, creating an electric atmosphere inside the ground. Jenkins' late conversion put Wales 32-31 up, and despite a last ditch drop goal effort from Mike Catt, they hung on for a famous victory.
